ABOUT THE 30 PLUS CLUB

In an effort to reward, recognize and promote academic excellence, Fayetteville High School created a 30 Plus Club. To become a member of the 30 Plus Club, students must score a composite score of 30 or higher on the ACT College Admission Exam.

This is an impressive achievement considering that only 1% of students nationally score a 33 or above and only 2% of students score over a 32.

Students who score a 30 rank in the top 5% of all test takers in the nation.

A plaque hangs in the entrance of Fayetteville High School with the name and picture of each 30 Plus Club member, graduation year and highest composite score.

The ACT College Admission Exam is taken by more than 1.9 million high school graduates nationally and over 80,000 in Tennessee every year.
