While each school has its own unique way of students receiving their meals, as the principals have mentioned in their videos, these are a few standard changes that you will encounter:

1. To Go Meals for Virtual learning students- If you are in need of meals and your child is registered as a virtual student, they are available. We ask that you please contact your child's school office, or cafeteria manager to let them know. Each school also has their own pick up and times. Your student's meal will need to be picked up at whichever school they attend; however the student does NOT need to be present to receive the meals.
2. Breakfast is still FREE. As we started last year, breakfast will be FREE for every student, no matter their lunch status.
3. Lunch is not free for every student. Unfortunately, USDA has put a stop to the emergency feeding where every child received every meal free. Therefore we are back to the regular school lunch program. The lunch prices are as follows

RAS- \$2.50 FMS- \$2.75 FHS - \$ 3.00
