FREE FLU SHOT EVENTS PLANNED NOVEMBER 9 TO “FIGHTFLUTN”
Lincoln County Health Department hosting events in the area

Fayetteville, Tenn. – Lincoln County Health Department will hold special “**FightFluTN**” event November 9 to provide flu shots at no charge to increase the number of people vaccinated against influenza in Tennessee. The Tennessee Department of Health urges all Tennesseans ages six months and older who have not yet received a flu shot this flu season to get one as soon as possible.

Lincoln County Health Department is offering free flu vaccines on November 9. From 1:00 PM to 4:00 PM at 1000 West Washington Street, Suite A, Fayetteville, TN 37334.

No appointments are needed to get a flu shot during these events.
